**CREATION OF A VISUAL ARTS AND CULTURAL ENRICHMENT TASK FORCE**

**WHEREAS:** the Governing Body desires that the visual arts as well as programs and services that provide cultural enrichment be increased and furthered in the City; and,

**WHEREAS:** to accomplish this desire the Governing Body wishes to establish a Task Force to make recommendations related to these matters.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF RIO RANCHO:**

That the City of Rio Rancho does hereby approve the creation of an Arts and Cultural Enrichment Task Force in accordance with the guidelines set forth below.

**Section A.** The Task Force shall:

- (1) Develop goals and objectives related to Public Art Program (i.e., visual arts) guidelines for consideration by the Governing Body;
- (2) Create a list of recommendations related to the decoration of public facilities such as City Hall, etc. for consideration by the Governing Body;
- (3) Create a Public Art Master Plan that identifies the locations for placement of public art throughout the City as well as a priority list.

**Section B.** The Task Force shall be comprised of seven members that will be selected by the Mayor from a pool of candidates who submit applications. Task Force members will be approved by the Governing Body. Task Force members serve at the pleasure of the Governing Body and may be removed at any time. The Mayor shall appoint persons within forty-five days of the formation of the Task Force, or within thirty days of a vacancy thereon. Vacancies shall be filled only for the remainder of any unexpired term by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council.

**Section C.** The City Manager shall appoint technical and administrative assistance to the Task Force from appropriate City departments and / or divisions.

**Section D.** Removal from this Task Force will comply with City Charter Section 33.03.

**Section E.** The Task Force shall exist for a period of one year from the date of full membership and will comply with City Charter Section 33.04. The Task Force will meet once monthly. The Task Force shall elect from its members a chairperson and a vice-chairperson that will serve until the expiration of the

4 **Section F.** The Task Force shall provide in writing an interim report detailing discussion  
5 and progress related to the Task Force's purpose to the Governing Body within  
6 90 days of its full membership appointment and two additional times before  
7 the expiration of this Task Force. The Task Force shall provide in writing a final  
8 report of suggested recommendations to the Governing Body following the  
9 final Task Force meeting.

11 **Section G.** No member of the Governing Body, nor any appointive officer or employee of  
12 the City, shall be appointed to the Task Force as a voting member. The  
13 Mayor, all other members of the Governing Body, and the City Manager or the  
14 City Manager's designee shall be ex-officio members of all boards,  
15 commissions, task forces, and advisory bodies.
